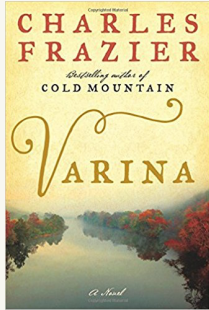

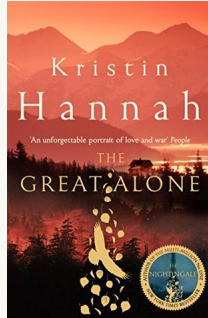


Varina

Wednesday, February 6

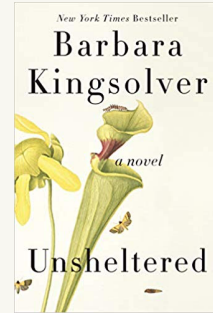


The Great Alone

Thursday, March 7

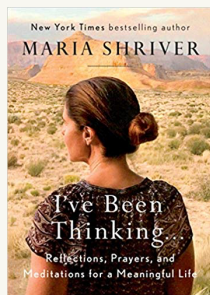


Unsheltered

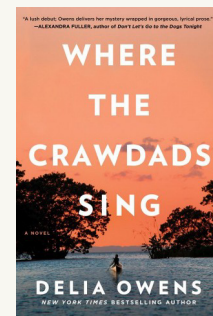
