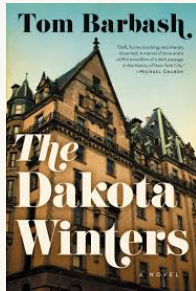


Winter to Spring 2020 Book Club Selections

The Book Club meets in the Parish House Library at 6 PM.

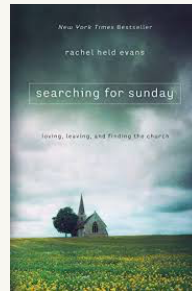


Wednesday, February 5

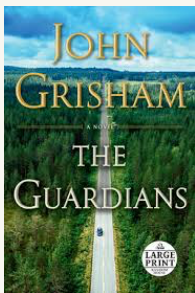

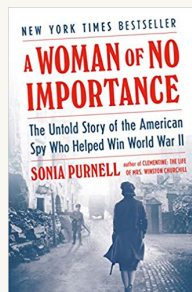


The Guardians

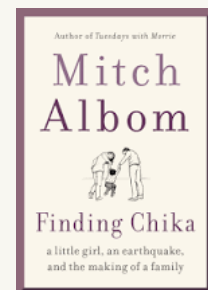


A Woman of No Importance
