Dear members and friends of Christ Church,

Thor: Love and Thunder (which opened in July) opens on a man and his daughter walking through the desert, clearly suffering. Despite repeated prayers to their god, the daughter dies and is buried. Shortly thereafter, the man comes to an oasis, where he finds the god celebrating, having neither heeded the prayers nor caring that the girl died, leading the man to conclude that there is no purpose to gods, that they are worse than useless and must be killed so they stop harming humankind. This scene is rather provocative for religious folks of all sorts because it raises the question, Why do you worship God?

We Christians have many answers, ranging from theological assertions like our need for Jesus' grace to deliver us from our harmful sinning and our reverence due to the one who created us to practical considerations like the habit we inherited from our ancestors and the loving community established by those who worship.

Occasionally wrestling with this question is important for all of us who believe: it helps us keep our own faith from becoming stale or rote, can help us understand those who have actively rejected or quietly drifted away from the faith because they didn't experience satisfactory answers in the church, and can give us talking points for sharing our faith with others.

For our August Public Theology, Pastor Daniel and I will be leading a discussion of this question. I encourage you to join us at Mountain Valley Brewing (4220 Mountain Valley Rd, Axtion) at 6pm on August 10.
