Dear members and friends of Christ Church,

The Annual Convention of the Diocese of Southwestern Virginia met at the Hotel Roanoke on January 24-26. Jay Dickens and Rives Coleman were your delegates, and Baylie Coleman represented Christ Church among the Youth @ Convention. In addition to the delegates passing the budget and a resolution calling us to pray for the people of Sudan as the genocide is ongoing, Bishop Mark announced the Diocese has given the property formerly known as St. Paul's, Martinsville to Church Without Walls, which has been worshiping there the past several years. While this is a sad announcement, marking as it does the end of the Episcopal presence on Fayette Street which ministered to many in that neighborhood, it does offer a resolution that was lacking when St. Paul's was closed but the Diocese continued to maintain the property.

Outside of worship with a few hundred Episcopalians on Sunday morning (during which Baylie excellently read from Nehemiah), the highlight of the Convention was the Rt. Rev. Elizabeth Gardner's keynote address (available under the Live tab at the Diocesan YouTube page - <a href="https://www.youtube.com/DIOSWVA">https://www.youtube.com/DIOSWVA</a>). Bishop Gardner entertainingly spoke to all of us, clergy and lay, as leaders in our respective churches, likening church leadership to riding one of those rickety old rollercoasters. She invited us to empower others in our churches, invest in people, solve the problems that are brought to us not only through technical fixes but by identifying possibilities for meaningful change, be both inspirational to and inspired by others, and stop being so mean to other people both inside and outside our churches. She reminded us that, while Christ will come again, the 1950s will not, and encouraged us to consider whether the leadership of the church, at all levels, reflects the people we want to draw into our fellowship (which was especially timely after Bishop Mark announced that, while he has not yet set an end date or called for the election of his successor, he is in the process of discerning when to conclude his ministry in this Diocese and what he will do next).
