

Dear members and friends of Christ Church,

Hopefully toward the end of this month, work will begin to address some issues with the exterior of the church building. As was the case with the parish house three years ago, the major presenting issue is rotting wood trim, which will be replaced, along with other painting of the roof and steeple. Among the smaller parts of the project is replacing the exterior door to the lift, which has suffered significant rot along the bottom and no longer sits flush in the frame (complicating the ushers' task of relocking the door after services).

Over the past several months, Senior Warden Rives Coleman, Treasurer Butch Hamlet, and former Senior Warden Jay Dickens have begun collecting pledges and gifts toward a 2025 Campaign, to pay not only for this work but several other projects: replenishing the cash reserve after we replaced two air handlers last summer, developing and executing a plan to landscape the campus and replace and/or add signage, replacing two other aging air handlers before they irreparably break, and saving toward the next large, unexpected building expense.

At present, we have received pledges totaling \$127,502 (that's 64% of our \$200,000 goal) and have nearly \$60,000 in hand, which has allowed us to complete our first objective (replenishing the cash reserve) and to contract for our second objective (the church exterior work beginning soon). If you have not already done so, you are invited and encouraged to make a pledge and/or send in a gift (checks with '2025 Campaign' in the memo can be left in the offering plate on Sunday) to help us maintain a lovely (and cool) church for years to come.
